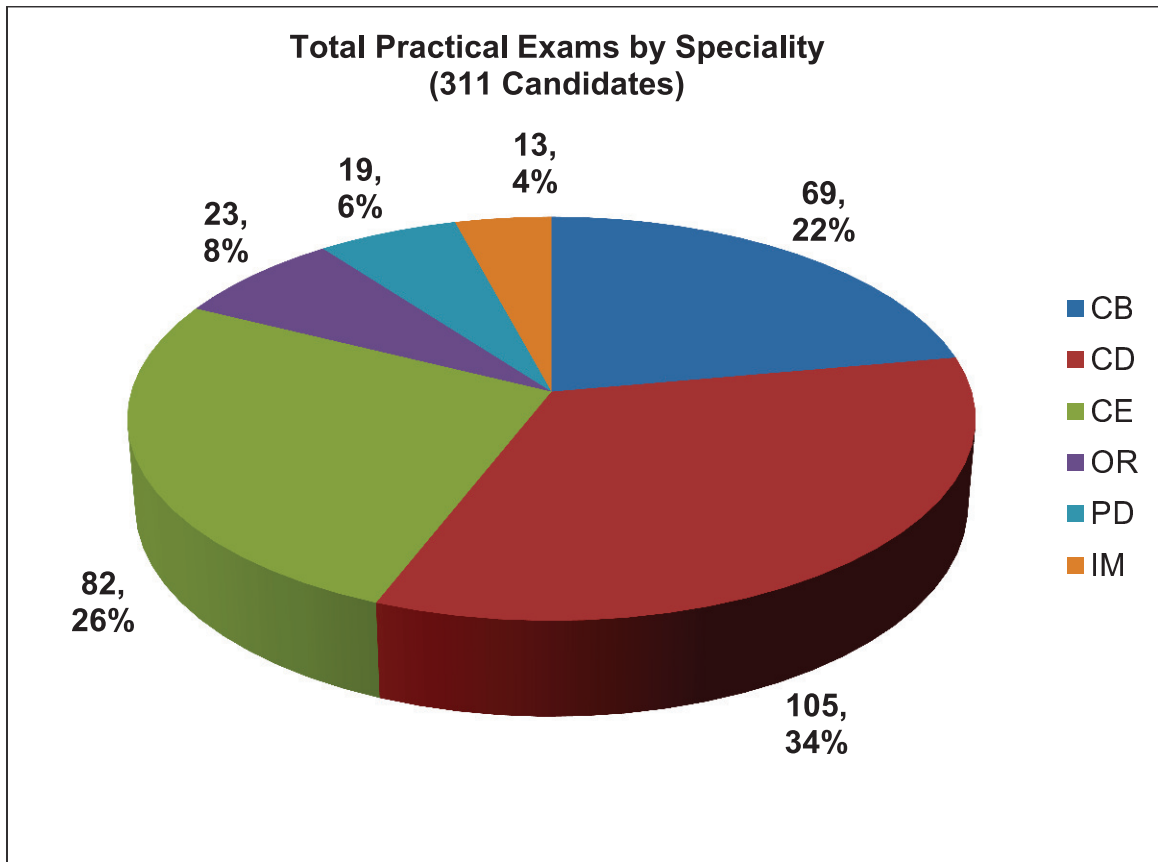

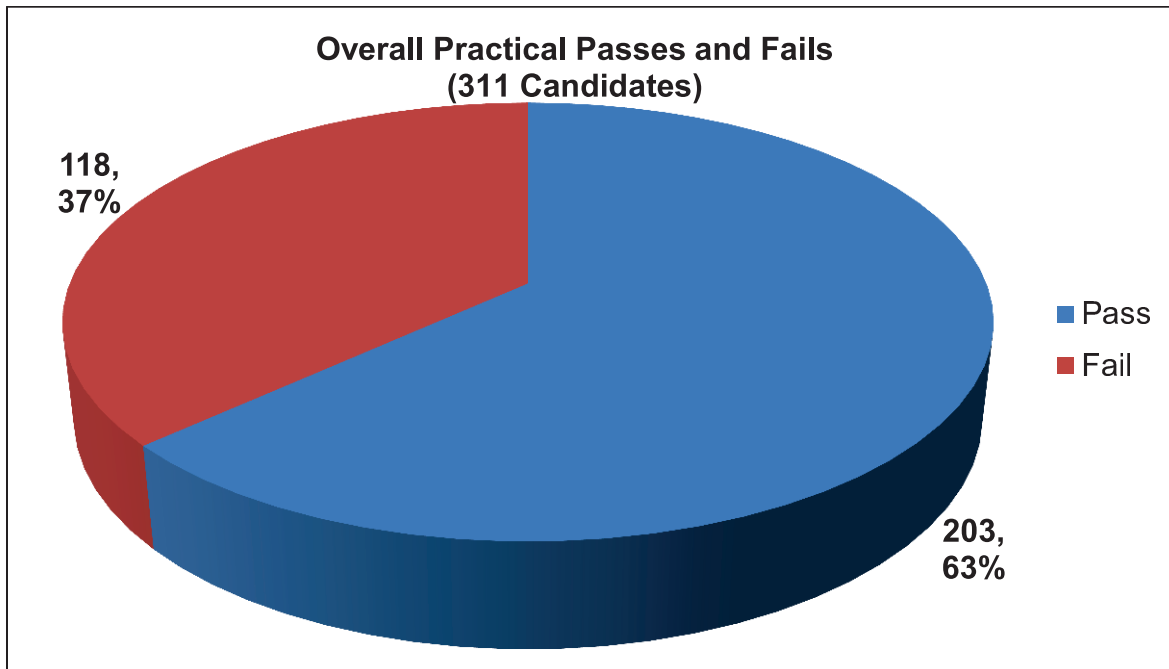


The proportion of candidates administered the Practical Examinations by Specialty area are presented in Figure 32. The largest portion of Practical Examinations administered were for CD (34%) and CE (26%) followed by CB (22%). OR (8%), PD (6%) and IM (4%) accounted for less than 18% of all examinees.

### ***Complete Dentures Practical Examination***

Figure 34 shows the proportion of candidates passing and failing the CD practical examination. Figures 35, 36 and 37 show the distribution of scores obtained by candidates taking each part of the CD Practical Examination. Candidates must obtain scores above the minimum passing score of 64% on each part of the examination in order to pass the examination. The red lines on the chart indicate the passing score. The absence of a red line indicates that all candidates scored above the passing point. Summary data for each criterion on the examination are presented below the figures in Table 23.
